- Awarded the contract for the FY2017 South Forty Street Improvements Project to the lowest, most qualified, responsive bidder, Jackson Paving Co., LLC, in the amount of \$211,475.00, based on their submitted line item bid.
- Adopted Ordinance 2016-05 granting application 2016-06-LUP\_CITY OF HIRAM: Application by Janet S. McMillen on approximately 1.073 acres for a land use permit in a commercial area for a structure to be used for dwelling purposes by the proprietor, or manager of the commercial use. Property is currently zoned LRO (Low Rise Office District) located in Land Lot 681; District 2, Section 3; West side of SR 92 (aka Hiram Douglasville Highway), north of Seaboard Street. (590 Hiram Douglasville Highway).
- Adopted Resolution 2016-08, authorizing the Mayor and Council to submit the FY2017 Local Maintenance and Improvement Grant application, with projects as follows:
  - 1) King Road Paving, provided that all necessary documents are in place by the last day of November 2016 at 5:00pm;  
If not,
  - 2) Speed control devices on Dallas Street, CW Sims Road, Seaboard Avenue, Center Street, and Oak Street (near the park)
- Scheduled a Work Session on December 20, 2016
- Mayor and Council adjourned the Special Session.
